This apparently happens for each file in the folder during the initial reading of the folder. I removed

IEFolderMView.IOOptionsEx := IEFolderMView.IOOptionsEx + [ieixWantParams];

And this problem stopped. But I still didn't get an icon or file extension. Adding this setting to the demo program did not cause a matching problem, perhaps because it doesn't include PDFium.
